
## HOW TO USE A SANDING BLOCK

To makeover a basic timber chair you should use three grits of sandpaper, which is called abrasive paper by the pros, and a cork sanding block.



**1.** The lower the grit, the courser it is. You'll need 80, 120 and 240, which is always marked on the back of the sheet.



**2.** To use the sheets with a sanding block, tear them in half lengthways.



**3.** Position the block at the top then fold the paper over.



4. Fold the paper onto the block firmly and crease the edges to hold it in place.



**5.** Hold the loose edge of the paper against the block while sanding. When the surfaces become smooth and worn, unfold the block to reveal the un-touched layer, refold and continue.
